RESULTS FOR THE 41ST GENERAL ELECTION ARE NOW OFFICIAL

The official results for Manitoba's 41st general election are now available on the Elections Manitoba website at www.electionsmanitoba.ca.

The results of the election changed the standing of parties in the Legislative Assembly as follows:

Registered Party	Candidates elected 2011	Candidates elected 2016
Manitoba Liberal Party	1	3
New Democratic Party of Manitoba	37	14
The Progressive Conservative Party of Manitoba	19	40

As per 165(2) of *The Elections Act* (EA), any candidate or voter in the electoral division may apply for a recount by May 2, 2016. If no application is made, the writs are returned to the chief electoral officer from each returning office on May 3, 2016, indicating which candidate has been elected in his or her electoral division.

Of 772,952 registered voters, 445,013 cast ballots in the 41st provincial general election. Voting took place at 2,766 voting stations in 1,200 voting places on election day, Tuesday, April 19, 2016. Turnout across the province was 57.57%, which compares to 55.77% in the last provincial election.

During the eight days of advance voting, April 9 to 16, 111,024 Manitobans cast their ballots at 293 advance voting locations across the province.

Elections Manitoba acknowledges the more than 10,000 returning officers, field staff and headquarters staff who worked in the election. We thank them for playing a role in the democratic process in our province.
