The Statement has been prepared by the Financial Officer based on the financial reporting provisions of *The Election Financing Act* of Manitoba.

Financial Officer's Responsibility for the Statement

The Financial Officer is responsible for the preparation of the Statement in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of *The Election Financing Act* of Manitoba, and for such internal control as the Financial Officer determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the Statement that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation of the statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the Financial Officer, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the Statement.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature and types of transactions inherent in any political party, the completeness of income and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our testing of income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the Party. Therefore, we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income, expenses and surplus (deficit) for the year ending December 31, 2016, assets and liabilities as at December 31, 2016 and the surplus (deficit) as at January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016.

Opinion

In our opinion, except for the effects of the matters described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, Form 920 – Annual Financial Statement of a Registered Party for the Manitoba Liberal Party as at, and for the year ending December 31, 2016, is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of *The Election Financing Act* of Manitoba.

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to Note 1 to the Statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The Statement is prepared to comply with the financial reporting provisions of *The Election Financing Act* of Manitoba. 2. Ownership

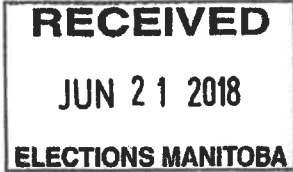
