AUDITORS' REPORT

We have audited the statement of income, transfers and expenses of **The Manitoba Liberal Party** for the election campaign period May 2, 2003 to August 4, 2003. This statement is the responsibility of the Party's executive. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these statements based on our audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, we conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the statement is free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the statement. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

In common with many political parties, the Party derives revenue from donations, fundraising and membership fees, the completeness of which is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of this revenue was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of the Party and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to revenue and excess of revenue over expenses.

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves concerning the completeness of the contributions referred to in the preceding paragraph, this statement presents fairly, in all material respects, the results of the Party's operations for the campaign period of May 2, 2003 to August 4, 2003 in accordance with The Elections Finances Act.
