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#### AUDITOR'S REPORT ON FORM 922, CANDIDATE'S FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND SUPPORTING SCHEDULES

To Kevin Thorvaldson, Official Agent for Gordon Dehn,

We have audited Form 922, Candidate's Financial Statements and Supporting Schedules, prepared in accordance with the accounting requirements of The Elections Finances Act of Manitoba and Accounting Guide – Accounting For Purposes of The Elections Finances Act issued by the Chief Electoral Officer, for the candidacy of Gordon Dehn for the candidacy period from July 11, 2006 to July 23, 2007 relating to the election held on May 22, 2007 in the Electoral Division of Selkirk. The financial statements are the responsibility of the Official Agent and the Candidate. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the financial statements based on our audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, we conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by the Official Agent and Candidate, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions income and donations in kind income and expenses is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of contribution income and donations in kind income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the candidate's election campaign records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to assets, liabilities, income, expenses, and the campaign period surplus/deficit.

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves as to the completeness of contribution income and donations in kind income and expenses referred to in the preceding paragraph, Form 922, Candidate's Financial Statements and Supporting Schedules for Gordon Dehn are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with the accounting requirements of The Elections Finances Act of Manitoba and Accounting Guide – Accounting For Purposes of The Elections Finances Act issued by the Chief Electoral Officer.
