**REVISION ENDS TOMORROW:
THURSDAY, AUGUST 22**

Manitobans have until tomorrow, August 22, to update their voter information or register to vote in advance of the election.

Eligible voters who did not receive a voter information card, or who received a card with incorrect information, should contact their returning office before 8:00 pm tomorrow to register or update their information. Returning office contact information can be found at https://www.electionsmanitoba.ca/downloads/RO_public_info.pdf.

Voters also have until tomorrow to register or update their information using Elections Manitoba's online voter registration service, at https://www.electionsmanitoba.ca/en/Voting/Register_Of_Voters.

Even if they are not registered, eligible voters can still vote if they show ID and take an oath at the voting place, either during advance voting or on election day.

WHO CAN VOTE?

To be eligible to vote, individuals must:

- be Canadian citizens;
- be at least 18 years old on election day; and
- have lived in Manitoba for at least six months immediately before election day.
