REVISION ENDS THURSDAY FOR THE PAS-KAMEESAK BYELECTION

The Pas-Kameesak voters can register or update their information until Thursday to receive a voter information card in the mail.

Eligible voters who have not received their card — or who received a card with out-of-date information — can register or update their information until July 2. Voters who register or update their information during the revision period will be mailed a voter information card.

[ElectionsManitoba.ca](https://electionsmanitoba.ca) is your trusted source of election information, and is available 24 hours a day for registration updates. Voters can also contact the local election office or satellite election office to:

- Register or update information
- Download digital voter information card
- Get information, candidates, advance and election dates, and voting options.

Voting is faster if you register before the election and bring your voter information card to the poll. Voters can still register and vote at the poll during advance voting and on election day.

Advance voting will be held from July 11 to 20 at the local election office, July 11 to 18 in Peguis First Nation, July 11 to 14 in Opaskwayak Cree Nation, July 13 in Pinaymootang First Nation (Fairford), and July 14 in Carrot River, Chemawin Cree Nation (Easterville), Cormorant, Fisher River Cree Nation, Kinonjeoshtegon First Nation (Jackhead), Grand Rapids, Pine Dock, and Wanless.
