## REVISION BEGINS TODAY FOR THE ST. BONIFACE PROVINCIAL BYELECTION

A revision period begins today for St. Boniface voters to add, update or correct their information on the voters list. Revision continues until June 28.

Voter Information Cards (VICs) have been mailed to voters on the preliminary voters list for St. Boniface. The card confirms that the voter is registered and provides information on where and when to vote.

Voters should contact the returning office to correct or remove their information. Voters who have not received a VIC may also register to vote. Revision and registration can be done at the returning office, or arrangements can be made for an election official to visit the voter's home.

Voters will receive their VICs in the mail after they have registered or revised their information on the voters list.

The returning office is open every day from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm except Sunday, when it is open from noon until 6:00 pm.

The byelection will be held Tuesday, July 17.
